

Skiers and Snowboarders: Join us for this popular midweek ski adventure as we return to one of the Mid-Altantic's premier ski resorts. Snowshoe is known for its balanced mix of beginner, intermediate, and advanced ski runs, along with terrain parks for riders of all abilities. With a summit elevation of 4,848', Snowshoe has some of the best snow in the region. Our package includes **four days of skiing or snowboarding**, **five nights lodging**, and one or two group social events (COVID permitting). We'll be staying slopeside in junior studio rooms at Expedition Station, with easy access to lifts and a variety of terrain. Each unit features a queen bed, sleeper sofa, and a small kitchenette. Participants will arrange their own transportation via personal auto or carpool. Driving time from the Peninsula is approximately 5½ hours.

Transportation: Personal auto or carpool. Jan. 9 (Sun.) and Jan. 14 (Fri.) are travel days.

Lodging: Slopeside at Expedition Station in the Snowshoe Village. "Junior studio deluxe" rooms for double or family occupancy (1 queen bed + 1 sleeper sofa), small kitchenette w/ microwave and refrigerator, WiFi, on-premises rental shop and ski storage, nearby dining options.

Skiing/Riding: Four-day lift ticket (Jan. 10–13, Mon.–Thurs.) includes afternoon and night skiing at Silver Creek.

Group meals: One après ski wine & cheese party and one group dinner (subject to pandemic considerations).

Optional Activities: Ski/snowboard/yoga lessons, snow tubing, snowmobiling.

Estimated Cost: *TBD per person* based on 20 participants and 2 persons/room. *Deduct TBD for non-skiers or lkon passholders.* \$25 discount for sign-up by Sept. 30. Actual cost could be higher or lower depending on participation and other factors. Equipment rental, lessons, and optional activities are extra.
